

Greetings Volunteers,

It's that time of year to submit our volunteer hours for the 2023 census. We are using the same on-line form that was well-received last year. The annual submission of our hours is **very important**. It documents to NYS public land managers, the North Country Trail Association, the National Park Service, and our financial auditors, the volunteer time and effort we have put forth to maintain and manage a foot trail across New York State.

If you are a volunteer who does trail work for an affiliate Club or Organization, please report your trail work hours to your Trails Chairperson early in January. For non-trail work, report your administrative and interpretive hours to your Club or Organization President or designated person. Remember to report your travel hours also. And, you may be able to claim a mileage deduction on your taxes.

If you are reporting on behalf of a sponsoring Club or Organization, or as an individual Trail Sponsor, or if you worked individual hours not reported elsewhere, **please continue reading**. Also continue reading if you are an RTC reporting for your region.

Thank you in advance for collecting volunteer hours and submitting your report by **February 28, 2024.** Use the census form on the FLTC website at: **Home>Members>Volunteer Trail Workers** or at this link:

Trail Sponsors (Clubs, Organizations, and individual Trail Sponsors) can request the \$5.00 per trail mile reimbursement for incidental expenses. Use the box at the bottom of the form.

Entries on the Form:


- First Name, Last Name, E-mail address and Organization (with a drop down menu listing various Clubs, Troops, etc.)
- Position (with a drop down menu listing various roles such as Sponsor, Club Chair, Reg. Coord., FLT Board, FLT Officer, Alley-Cat, TMT, Other, etc.)
- Map (with a drop down menu listing individual maps, groups of maps for Clubs, Organizations, Sponsors, and Regional Trail Coordinators, There is also an FLT System-wide entry for volunteering for the FLT Trail System or the FLTC.
- Hours five categories, each to include both travel time and work time spent on both private land and public land:
 - 1. Trail Work maintenance and construction
 - 2. **Administration (Admin)** meetings, office work, writing, editing, accounting, etc.
 - 3. **Interpretation and Outreach (Interp)** promotion, education, brochure development, leading hikes, etc.
 - 4. **General Resource Work (GRW)** GIS/GPS mapping, planning, land protection/acquisition
 - 5. **Training (Train)** construction, maintenance, safety, sawyer, etc.)
- **Public Land** (with a drop down menu listing various State Forests, Parks, etc.)



- Hours for Public Land to include that portion of the total hours entered above that were spent on various public lands
- Comments to briefly describe work accomplished, problems and proposed future projects
- Mileage Reimbursement (for Trail Sponsors only) use the box if you would like to request mileage reimbursement at \$5/mile

Important to Note:

- Group projects such as those performed by FLTC-organized work parties and Alley-Cat crews will be reported by the Director of Crews & Construction or the Project Manager. Individual workers should not report these hours.
- Stewards or Adopters working for a Trail Club or organization should not use this form. Their hours should be reported by the Trail Club Chairs.
- The Public Land Hours in the lower section of the form are part of the total hours submitted in the Maps section of the form. They are **not** additional hours. (See the example below; notice that 148.5 of the 633 total hours reported in green were worked on public land reported in blue. One half of the total FLT System-wide hours reported should be reported in Public Land hours since approximately half of the miles in the FLTC system are in public lands.)
